Lyle was born to Howard House and Vivian Wilcox House on Aug. 19, 1935, in Oregon City. They moved to the coast soon after.

They then moved to Vale, where they lived on a farm, growing sugar beets and asparagus.

Lyle moved to Canby during high school, logging during the summer with his dad. Lyle graduated from Canby High School in 1953.

On Feb. 5, 1954, he married Dian Lillian Yoder. Lyle was in the National Guard and was honorably discharged in July 1954. He also was in the military until July 1962.

Lyle and Dian moved to Crescent City, California, where Lyle logged after his military service. After 14 years, Lyle moved to Republic, Washington, for two and a half years. He continued to log.

His next move was to Corvallis. Lyle retired from logging and worked the rest of his career as a storekeeper and in the mailroom at Oregon State University. He retired Oct. 27, 1993.

Lyle was an officer of the Moose and Elks lodges, and enjoyed hunting, fishing, camping, gold mining and raising his four daughters. He was preceded in death by his parents and his daughter, Barbara Morford. He is survived by his loving wife of 61 years, Dian Lillian House; daughters Lorelei Steagall, Wendy Lane and Brenda Murphree; sister, Glenna Loftin; seven grandchildren; and four great-grandchildren.
