Albert H. Morrison, formerly of Corvallis, died Jan. 18, 2008, at the Oregon Veterans Home in The Dalles. He was 85.

Albert was born July 26, 1922, in Halfway, the oldest of three children born to Henry and Mildred Perry Morrison.

Albert graduated from Eagle Valley High School in Richland in 1940. He married his high school sweetheart, Odetta Irene Chandler, on July 26, 1941, in Eugene. They made their home in nearby Crescent Lake until he entered the service. Albert served in the Army Air Corps during World War II and was stationed on Shemya Island of the Aleutian Islands. Following the war, they moved to Powell Butte and then returned to Richland for 13 years before settling in Corvallis in 1959. Albert worked for the Pine-Eagle Cooperative in Richland, Sunny Brook Dairy in Corvallis and the Benton County Road Department, retiring in 1984. Albert loved camping, traveling, trips to Reno and Spirit Mountain and especially spending time with his family.
