Cindy R. Arbuckle Jenkins, 65, of Philomath passed away Thursday, July 27 at Good Samaritan Regional Medical Center.

Cindy was born to Henry C. and Opal L. (Moore) Arbuckle on October 16, 1951 in Corvallis, Oregon. She graduated from Philomath High School in 1969, received an Associate degree from Linn Benton Community College, and later a Bachelors degree in Business Administration from Oregon State University in 1982.

Cindy worked at OSU for 28 years in the Office of Human Resources as Benefits Analyst, and later as a Human Resources Information System Analyst. Cindy retired from OSU in June of 2011.

Family and friends were very important to Cindy. She was an incredible listener and made everyone feel special and valued.

Cindy was preceded in death by her father, Henry C. Arbuckle.

She is survived by her daughter, Debbi McCaskill; her mother, Opal (Moore) Arbuckle; her sisters and spouses, Susan and Arnie Powell, Debbie and Steve Delmore, and Rhonda and Ken Stone; grandchildren, Jordan Leavitt, Paul McCaskill, Hunter McCaskill, and Jessi McCaskill; great-grandson, Henry Leavitt; and many nieces, nephews, and cousins.

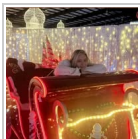
