David L. Shriver, 79, of Corvallis died January 6, 2018.

Born in Clifton, Colorado, the middle child of Herschel and Mabel Shriver's five children, he served in the US Navy and was stationed in San Diego, where he met and married Hazel (Jeani) McKee. Following completion of his degree in engineering at Weber State, Dave worked for Hewlett Packard for 1970 until his retirement in 1996. An adventurer and athlete, he traveled the world with Jeani, owned and flew two small airplanes, and was an avid golfer and fly fisherman.
