November 4, 1919 - February 17, 2018

Edith Ella (Wells) Miller passed away Saturday, February 17, 2018 at the age of 98. She was born November 4th, 1919 in New York City to John Andre and Clara (Erdmann) Wells. She spent most of her childhood in The Dalles.

She attended Oregon Agricultural College in Corvallis, pursuing a degree in Fiber Arts. There she met Clair Edmund Miller and they wed December 19, 1942 at his farm south of Corvallis. She was an active helper on the farm until his death in 1985. In 1993 she married a cousin of Clair's, Lloyd Herschel Miller. They continued to reside south of Corvallis until his death in 2005.

She was a charter member of the Corvallis Weavers Guild and continued to pursue fiber arts throughout her life. She was also involved with Oregon Women for Agriculture and Oregon Farm Bureau.
