Eugenia “Jean” Brooks Rodecap peacefully passed away at age 90 on Saturday, Aug. 25, at the Mennonite Home in Albany, in the presence of her family.

She had lived at the Mennonite Home for the previous six years.

Jean was born in Whittier, Calif., to Earl and Harriet Goold Brooks. She married Roger Rodecap on Aug. 22, 1942, and graduated from Whittier College in 1943.
