Frederick William Turrell, 85, of Corvallis died Thursday at Good Samaritan Regional Medical Center.

He was born in Central Point to Albert and Virgie Owens Turrell. He moved to Harrisburg when he was 10 years old, graduating from Harrisburg High School in 1942. He served in the U.S. Navy from 1943 to 1946. He married Lila Falk on Sept. 1, 1946, in Halsey.

Frederick worked in the farming industry and as a truck driver. He lived in the Harrisburg-Halsey area most of his life, except for five years spent in Newberg before his retirement. He retired to Corvallis in 1990. He looked forward to attending his Harrisburg High School reunions each year, and loved visiting with family and friends; the coffeepot was always on!

He was a member of the Charity Grange, and enjoyed working with wood and growing beautiful gardens and dahlias.

Frederick is survived by his son, Richard Turrell of Heppner; daughter, Linda Eichner of Harrisburg; brothers Vangie Turrell of Medford and Donald Turrell of Junction City; sister, Alerta Bird of Tulare, Calif.; seven grandchildren; and seven great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Lila Falk Turrell; and brother, Raymond Turrell.
