He enlisted in the army in 1943. While stationed at Fort Sill, Oklahoma, he met and married Winnie Mae Bradley in 1944. Jack was a WWII veteran, having fought in combat with the U.S. 9th Army in Germany, until the war ended.

Jack's working career consisted of Meadow Gold Dairies, Richie's Market and Valley Linen. He then retired and moved to live by the Alsea River, where he and Winnie loved to fish. They eventually moved back to the Albany area to be closer to family and friends. He loved OSU sports and was very knowledgeable on the history of the Beavers, going back to 1944.

He is survived by his wife, Winnie, of 69 years, three sons: Dave (wife, Maryann), Chuck (wife, Linda) and Jeff (wife, Lynne); sister, Mary Jo Levenspiel (husband Octave); seven grandchildren and 12 great-grandchildren.
