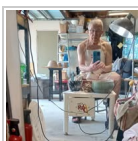
Crabbing, we got a slew of crab. Enough we were able to trade crab for wine with a winery!

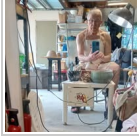

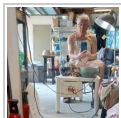

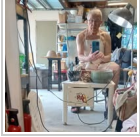
