Joseph Edward “Edgar” Immergluck, 86, of Corvallis, died of natural causes Sunday, Aug. 25, 2013.

A memorial celebration will take place at 2 p.m. Sunday, Aug. 31, in the Fireside Room of First Congregational United Church of Christ.

Edgar was born on July 24, 1927, in Bielsko, Poland, to Daniel Aaron “Tadek” Immergluck and Felicja Schoengut Immergluck. His life journey took him from Poland to Shanghai, China, during World War II, and then on to the San Francisco Bay Area, where he graduated from University of California, Berkeley, in chemical engineering, and where he met Jeanne Marie Bachman, to whom he was married for 50 years.

His professional career took him and his family to Salt Lake City, Utah, where he loved to ski and be in the mountains. He finally moved to Corvallis in 2005 to join his beloved partner, Margaret Orsi.

Edgar is survived by his sister, Thea Eckstein; his loving children, Robert and Karin; his son-in-law, Michael; his niece, Maria; nephew, Alan; his beloved grandchildren, Sarah and Andreas; and his partner, Margaret.
