Karen Jane Collie of Corvallis passed away Thursday. She was 63. She was born in Albany to Robert L. and Karen E. Fitzpatrick Collie. She worked for the federal government for 34 years, including working in Alaska as a dedicated realty specialist with the Bureau of Land Management for approximately 20 years.
