



## Kim Le Nguyen Sleeper

July 10, 1969 - July 23, 2025

Kim Le Nguyen Sleeper was born on July 10, 1969, in Bien Hoa, South Vietnam. In April 1975, at the end of the war, Kim, his mother Phuong, and his brother Minh came to the USA as refugees. They settled in Corvallis, Oregon, where Kim resided his entire life.

Kim's mother Phuong, now known as Julie, married Andrew Sleeper in 1981. Andrew adopted Kim and Minh as his own children in 1982.

In 1987, Kim graduated at the top of his class at Corvallis High School. That same year, Andrew, Julie and Minh moved to Fort Collins, Colorado, but Kim began his adult life in Corvallis.

Kim developed many skills, and he held many different jobs. With his generosity, intelligence, resourcefulness, and kindness, Kim had numerous friends.

Kim was diagnosed with acute myeloid leukemia (AML) in September 2024, and he was being treated for that disease. On July 22, 2025, he suffered a stroke, and Kim died at Good Samaritan hospital on Wednesday, July 23, 2025. He will be deeply missed by all who know him.

Kim is survived by his parents: Julie and Andrew, and his two brothers: Minh

and Pascal.
