Following graduation he was commissioned in the US Army as an artillery officer stationed at Fort Sill OK.

The family moved back to Corvallis in 1962 and the family grew when son Scott was born in 1965. Lew earned MS in Bio Chemistry 1967 worked in the OSU department of Agricultural chemistry until 1983. Lew & Carol purchased Alexander's Deli in 1982 and enjoyed serving friends and family delicious meals for the next four years. Around this same time Lew began a 20 year career driving school bus for Corvallis school district and driving fire crews each summer.
