“*Marvin Paul Fredrickson III, 62, of Philomath Oregon passed away on April 22, 2018 at Good Samaritan Hospital in Corvallis, OR with wife Carol Fredrickson by his side. For the last year he battled a rare Kidney Cancer and after completing his bucket list of traveling to see all his siblings, he died with dignity and grace. Family was the most important thing to him and he held on long enough to bid farewell to all his kids and grandkids before he left to be greeted by those who went before him.*

Marvin was born on October 10, 1955, in Sacramento California to Marvin P. II and Syble Harlene Fredrickson. Marvin moved around as a child but considered Placerville his childhood home. He served our country in the United States Army from November 1973 – December 1978. During his time in the military he fell in love with Carol Ann Rowe and her daughter Christina Leann. Marvin and Carol were married in Roseville, CA on May 4, 1974. Nine months later they welcomed daughter Jennifer Diane to the world, followed by namesake Marvin Paul IV in September 1978. Shortly after the birth of his son, he was honorably discharged from the military and started his civilian career in May 1979 as an Electrician with Spencer Electric in Reno, Nevada, where he would stay until June 1988. After a brief time in Orangevale, California, he moved to Philomath, Oregon in 1993 where he continued his career until he retired in March 2017. While in Oregon he and his bride were foster parents and fell so deeply in love with Seth Marcus that they decided to adopt him in 1997.

Marvin was a devoted husband, loving father, and God-fearing Christian who was baptized into Christ on October 13, 1989 in Folsom, CA at the Church of Christ. He was active in the community and volunteered his time to the Nashville Food Bank, the Wren Community Building remodel, and helped the elderly, single moms and many others with home projects. His hobbies included hunting, fishing, wine making, and gardening. He also maintained a beautiful home for his beloved wife.

Preceding him in death were his parents Marvin Paul Fredrickson II and Syble Harlene Wise (Davis), step dad Byron Francis Backman, brother Jerry Byron Backman, and sister Patty Kelly (Fredrickson).

He leaves behind wife of 44 years, Carol Ann Fredrickson, as well as four children -- daughters Christina Leann and Jennifer Diane, as well as sons Marvin Paul IV and Seth Marcus. His seven grandchildren are Kyle David, Shane Joseph, Patchouly Gale, Jonah Dove, Daniel Adir, Marvin Paul V, and Kailey Autumn Marie. He also had five Great grandkids -- Nathaniel, Torrance, Orion, Alexander, and June. He also leaves behind five brothers (Aron Backman, Dennis Backman, Daniel Backman, Billy Backman, and Rick Backman) as well as seven sisters (Kathy Smith, Karen Fredrickson, Suzzanne Gearhart, Deborah Smith, Sherry Deems, Judy Egan, and Janice Fredrickson).
