Mike , youngest of the three children of Charles and Rose Wolf, was born in Syracuse , NY where he graduated from Nottingham High School in 1943. He

served in the U.S. Navy during WW2 and in the U.S. Air force during the Korean conflict. His Bachelor of Science degree in geophysics was awarded by the N.M. Institute of Mining and Technology in 1951, and he received a Master of Science degree in atmospheric sciences from the University of Washington in 1962.

He and Jo were married at her family home in Superior, NE in 1954. They resided , at various times In Texas, Missouri, Washington, California and Oregon during his 30 year career of research which concluded in 1986 when he retired as an Associate Professor from Oregon State University. Following retirement and a transitional stint as a Corvallis school bus driver, he became involved in environmental and societal causes and was an enthusiastic volunteer with a variety of service groups in Corvallis.

Jo and Mike enjoyed the many culture and sports events of Corvallis, as well as taking advantage of the local out-of-doors opportunities. Mike was an enthusiastic and persistent vintner of his home-grown vinifera grapes. An active life style was reflected in their extensive travels in Europe, North America and New Zealand/Australia that included 15 Elder-hostels (Roads Scholars).

Mike is survived by their daughter Susan Wolf of Sekiu, WA; their son and daughter-in-law, Steve and Janet Wolf of Soda Springs, ID; step-grandsons Eli, Adam and Chris and their families. Deaths of Mike's sister, Sylvia F. Wolf, and brother, Jerome A. Wolf, preceded his.
