Maurine June Humbert, 95, of Lebanon, passed away October 29, 2022 at Avamere Nursing Home.

Maurine was born on June 13, 1927 in Prairie du Sac, Wisconsin to Dewey Albertus and Bernice (Leppla) Albertus. Maurine grew up with four siblings, William (Bill) Albertus, Robert (Bob) Albertus, Sara (Albertus) Eberhart, and Mary (Albertus) Kyle. They all preceded her in death.
