Sue was honorably discharged the following year, at the rank of Specialist 5. Following her discharge, Sue and Robbie moved back to Corvallis.

Sue graduated from Linn Benton Community College in 1986. Shortly afterwards, Sue started working at Oregon State University, first in the Economics Department, then Telecommunications where she had planned to retire on March 1st.
