William Low, 92, of Albany, died Friday, May 17, 2013 after a short illness.

He was born in Dundee, Scotland, the eldest of six children. Bill was the beloved father of Marjorie MacLaren and Duncan Low. He was the loving husband of Charlotte, now residing in the Mennonite village. Charlotte is the mother of Peggy Collins and husband, Floyd. William's first wife, Sibyl, died in 1997. A decorated veteran of World War II (Royal Signal Corps), he served in North Africa as a desert rat. The family moved via Canada to the United States, where William's engineering for Boeing and Rockwell contributed to the lunar landing and the space shuttle.

A man of many talents with a zest for life, he loved to read, tell lively stories about his experiences, sing and dance, paint, go fishing and play the bagpipes as a pipe major.
