Zachary S. Peters, age 16, died unexpectedly of natural causes at his home on Wednesday, March 25, 2015. Born on August 18, 1998 in Corvallis, Oregon to Steve and Cathy Peters, Zach was a sophomore at Crescent Valley High School.

Zach was a one-of-a-kind showman with an incredible sense of humor, and a caring heart with a compassion for other people. Zach brightened the lives of those he met with his extraordinary personality and positive outlook on life. He was a member of Crescent Valley Choir, and the Good Samaritan Episcopal Church Handbell Choir. A joy in his life was participating in various area talent shows as well as hosting Friday night "Just Dance" parties with many of his friends. He was best known for entertaining us all with his dancing and singing talents, and his popular YouTube Channel. Zach lived his 16 years to the fullest and enjoyed a happy life.

Zach is survived by his parents; sisters, Nikki and Lexi Peters; grandparents, Allen and Jean Peters, Diane Wolfe and Jim Hildenbrand and Joyce Neeley; many uncles, aunts, cousins, and friends.

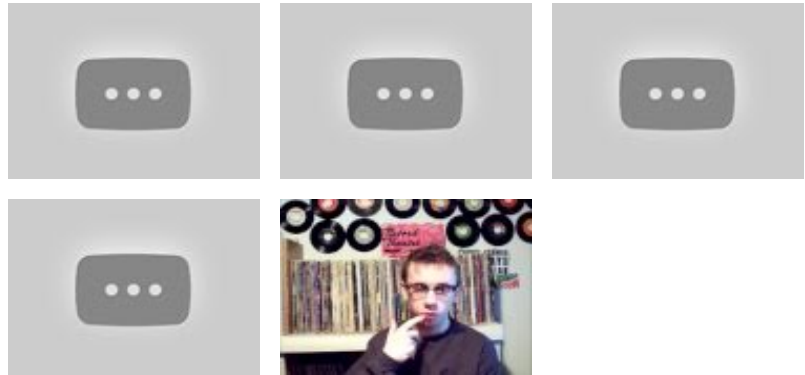

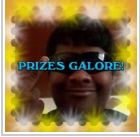

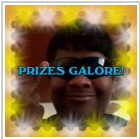

I know you are up there teaching the angels the "Smooth Criminal" dance Z. And I hope you save a dance for me.

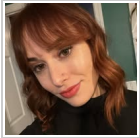

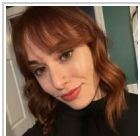
